AG22/051 To receive apologies.

AG22/052 Public participation for twenty minutes to allow members of the public present to raise questions and make comments regarding the Neighbourhood Plan.

Troy planning will draft a list of visions and objectives and send to the group for consideration. It is likely to include e.g., housing, employment, and climate change. The list will be with the group before the next meeting on 13th February 2023.

AG22/056 Update on call for sites and recap on SHELAA sites

SHELAA sites are those typically not allocated for development, and which have previously been unidentified or unexpected. Nine sites have been listed in Alresford. NPAG have applied for technical support package grant funding. Aecom will therefore, take on the task of assessing all the SHELAA sites and will report back to NPAG on their suitability.

AG22/057 To review the current Actions.

Troy Planning provided an action table detailing all key aspects of the Neighbourhood Plan work undertaken so far. This includes housing,

employment, design & character, biodiversity, communal facilities, heritage, town centre and mobility.

Green space in Alresford must be protected including the large new 16 ha open space which will be provided at the new Sun Hill development. These green spaces will be mapped for April NPAG meeting by Aecom.

Heritage & Biodiversity criteria is also to be developed.
